TASTING NOTES

Cherry with purple reflections, it presents an interesting range of aromatic compounds and complexity. Fresh and balanced, complex and fruity and impregnated with the notes of the terroir, it shows breadth of flavors in the passage through the mouth and a fresh, spicy and slightly mineral finish.

VINEYARDS

The Cariñena (*aka Carignan or Mazuelo*) vineyards grow in clay soils, the Garnacha vines are planted in soils of slate (*Llicorella*) and the Syrah vineyards are planted in limestone soils. Together the diverse terroir brings complexity to this wine.
