**TASTING NOTES**

A muscular wine that displays notes of ripe fruit, exotic spices and hints of bitter chocolate. Firm, mouth-coating tannins and a taut acidity give way to a long, spicy finish with some remembrances of earth and red berries. Wooden notes are present, but not prominent.

**VINEYARDS**

Prieto Picudo grapes are autochthonous from the province of Leon. The creeping grapevines are planted in the traditional "vaso" system or head-pruned bunches and grapes are small with a very high potential for aging.
