TASTING NOTES

Vivid purple in the glass. Aromas of florals and ripe berries are complemented by a subtle spice. Supple with juicy acidity. Blackberry, blueberry, and black plum are balanced with mocha flavors. Velvety tannins compliment the sweet fruit, closing with very good persistence.

VINEYARDS

The Tempranillo grapes for this wine are from very old vines of up to 100 years, trained in the traditional “vaso” system, and which produce very low yields. The vineyards are in the areas of El Pego and Villanueva de Campeán, within the province of Zamora, in the regions of Toro and Tierra del Vino respectively, and are planted on top layer of gravel over very sandy soils.
